WHAT IS APOKRIES?

Gosh – we're already talking about Easter and Christmas hasn't even arrived! We may as well start selling hot cross buns! But seriously – a lot of people aren't aware of Apokries - so what is it? Every year, on the weekend prior to Orthodox Lent, a carnival season called '[Apokries](#)' takes place. It is celebrated throughout most Orthodox countries around the world and marks the last celebration before 40 days of fasting. The word itself, Apokries, comes from the Greek words 'apo' and 'kreas' which translates to 'from meat,' meaning abstaining from meat. It symbolises the commencement of the Lent fast which includes having no meat for 40 days.

So there you have it – another beautiful cultural celebration of our faith. And we already have something in mind to celebrate for this – during our Welcome Dinner/Cocktail Event in February 2026!
